Home Learning Challenges

Talk to a grown-up about favourite toys. Tell them about your favourite toy and find out about your grown-up's favourite toys that they played with when they were your age. Maybe they could use the Internet to find a picture of it for you to see.



Look through some photos of special events that you and your family have shared since you were born. Can you remember any of these events? Talk to a grown-up about what you remember about each photo.



Spend some time with an older relative or friend to talk about things they remember from when they were at school. Find out how school has changed since then. Tell them what it is like at your school now.



Talk to someone in your family about the kinds of jobs people do. Have you seen a bus driver, a shop assistant or a doctor? What do you know about their jobs and what would you like to find out? You could draw a picture of what job you would like to do when you are older.



Do you have any photos of when you were a baby? Are there photos of when your grown-ups were babies? Talk about what they looked like and what kind of things they did when they were babies. How have they changed?

Text Ask a grown-up to help you find some old photos of where you live. What still looks the same? What has changed?
