Home Learning Challenges

With a grown-up, go for a walk around your local area. Take some photos of the things you see. You could draw a map of your walk to show the different places you visit.

Create your own 'My Special Places Map', showing places that are special to you. Draw different locations, such as your home, school or park. Then, tell a sibling or another family member about your map.

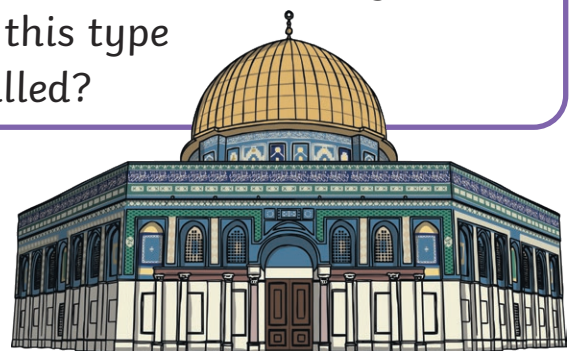
Look at some maps of places around the world. Can you find where you live? Can you find a place that is usually hot and sunny? Can you find a place that is often cold and snowy?



Tell someone in your family about a place you have visited. How did you travel there? What do you remember about the place? How far away was it? Ask other people in your family where they have visited. Have some people been to another country? Can you find it on a map and can you find some pictures of what it is like?

Talk about any festivals you celebrate with your family. What do you do to celebrate? Are there other festivals that you have talked about at school? Do any of your friends celebrate other festivals? What do you know about these celebrations?

Are there any religious buildings in your local area that you could visit? What features can you see on this building? Do you know what this type of building is called?
