Home Learning Challenges

Collect some junk-modelling materials and use them to create a room for the bears. Can you make some chairs or some beds? What else will you add?



Goldilocks and the Three Bears love eating porridge. Can you try making some porridge with a grown-up? Try putting some different toppings onto your porridge. You could use a little jam, fruit or honey. Do you like porridge? Which topping do you prefer?



Use books or the Internet to find out an interesting fact about real bears. Can you draw a picture about your fact or write it down? Perhaps you could take this into school to share with the other children.

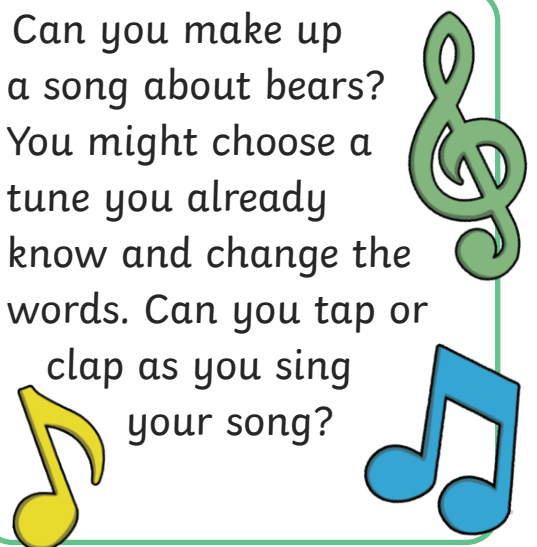
Draw a picture of your favourite part of the story. Can you write the names of any of the things you have included in your picture? What sounds can you hear in the name? Which letters will you need?



Draw 3 bears. Take a handful of buttons, counters or other items. Try sharing them between the bears. How many does each bear get? How many are there altogether?



Can you make up a song about bears? You might choose a tune you already know and change the words. Can you tap or clap as you sing your song?
