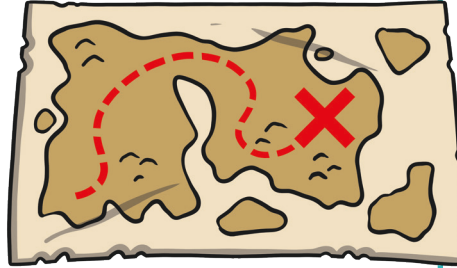


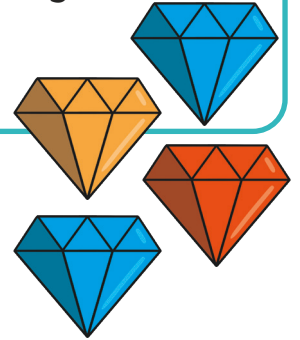
# Pirates

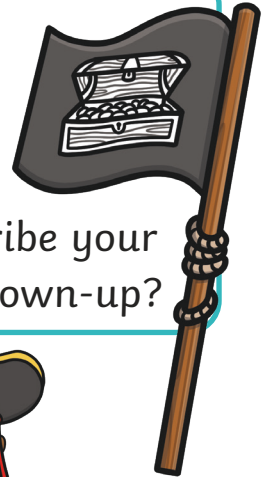


Penny the Pirate hid 7 jewels. She has found 4 of them. How many are still missing? Explain how you can work this out.

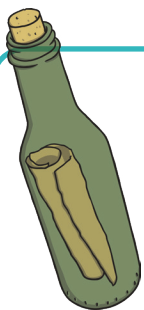


The Pirate Captain is making a list of the pirates in his crew. Choose some pirate names and help him by writing them down.
